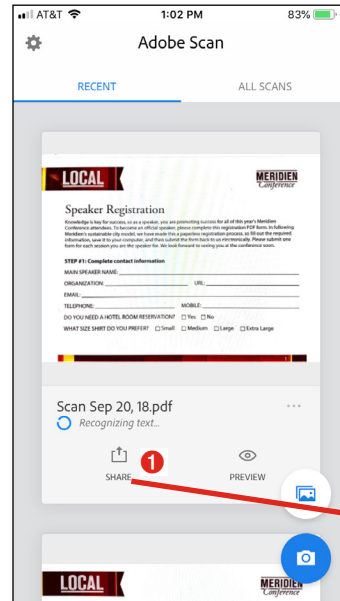
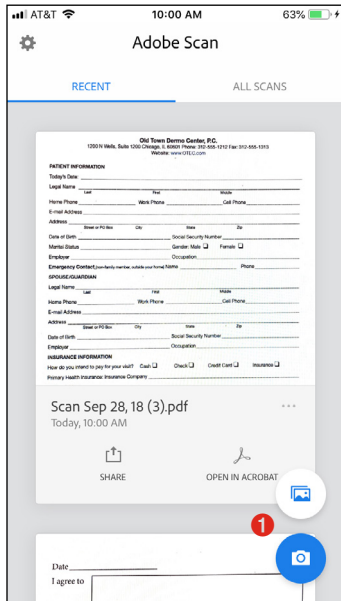
Cut the paper clutter with Adobe Scan.
The free Adobe Scan app works on your mobile device,
scans documents into PDFs, and automatically recognizes text.

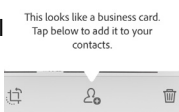


You need an Adobe or Enterprise ID to use Adobe Scan.

1 Select the pages icon (top right of number 1) to chose from previously scanned documents, or the camera icon to capture a page(s) new document. Note how easily it captures a page.

New feature:

Adobe Scan will also capture business cards and add them to your contact list.



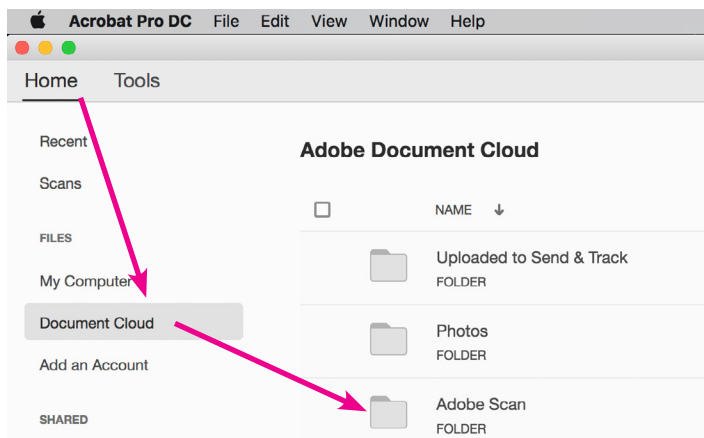
After capturing a document of one or more pages, the document can be edited.

1 Take another Photo or Select from Photos.
2 Reorder pages
3 Crop
4 Rotate
5 Edit color
6 Delete
7 After any edits, click Save as PDF. Adobe Scan OCRs the page(s) and saves the PDF to the Document Cloud. View it immediately in Acrobat mobile.

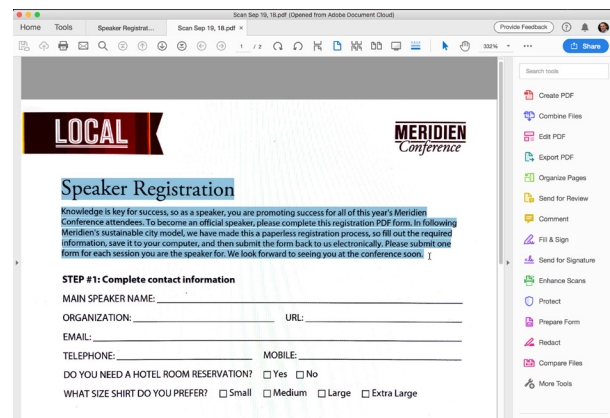
After recognizing text and saving to the Document Cloud, the PDF can be viewed in the Acrobat Reader mobile.

1 Or use Share Link and email to share links to your file. Anyone with the link can view it.

1 Search for text in the scanned PDF.



In Acrobat DC, find the scanned files in Home> Document Cloud> Adobe Scan



If needed, select the scanned text and copy/paste it elsewhere.
